Welcome

Summer School will be held for nine (9) weeks this year, starting on Monday, June 13 through Friday, August 12.

Standard Summer Program

The standard summer program is similar to the classes during the school year. It covers language & literacy, math and science, music, art and crafts, physical exercise, and some fun water activities! For the elementary age class(es), math, reading and writing workshops will help children sustain their academic level throughout the long summer!

Intensive Japanese Program

Would you like your child(ren) to learn more Japanese? Here's the chance. From the moment that your child(ren) step into the Japanese class, they will be immersed in Japanese throughout the day. Arts & Craft, Music & Movement and Learning Time will all be conducted in Japanese! Useful Japanese vocabulary will be introduced through activities, songs, games, situational studies/role-playing, cooking and much more! Introduction to reading hiragana/katakana/kanji will be included for Kindergarten age and older students. We will offer fun-filled activities promoting Japanese language and culture to help children make a stronger connection with their host country, Japan.

Classrooms: Will be posted on the bulletin boards at school on your child's first day of school.
- Application: Students who are currently enrolled at Yoyogi International School have first priority acceptance and their siblings have second priority acceptance until April 15. Applications from non-Yoyogi students will be accepted starting April 18. Upon receipt of the summer school application form and availability, your child's place will be reserved.
- Tuition: Please refer to the **weekly** tuition list in each section. Tuition fees will be calculated by the number of weeks applied. Invoice will be sent by early May. (5% tax is included in the tuition fees.)
- Tuition Due Date:
June 2, 2011
No refunds are available.
If payment is not received by the given due date, your child's space in class will be automatically cancelled.

Enrollment Schedule:

Yoyogi students, graduates and new students who have registered to enroll for the upcoming 2011-2012 school year have the choice to attend 2 - 5 days a week, for 1 to 9 weeks.

****Only the 5 days/week program is available for other children not mentioned above (with the exception of the Elementary Class).**

Important Notes:

Please be advised of the following:

1. After-school extended hours program is not available.
2. Lunch service is not available.
3. Morning drop-off service is available.
4. Children may not bring medication to school, and no medication will be administered during summer school. (please ask your physician to prescribe medication dosages to twice per day instead of three times a day)
5. Yoyogi International School does not have the facilities nor the trained staff to support children who are physically challenged or require special needs.

Items to bring to school:

1. Lunch and drink
2. Extra set of clothes
3. Diapers & wipes (if necessary)
4. Indoor shoes (for non-Yoyogi students)
5. Bathing suit & towel (from July)

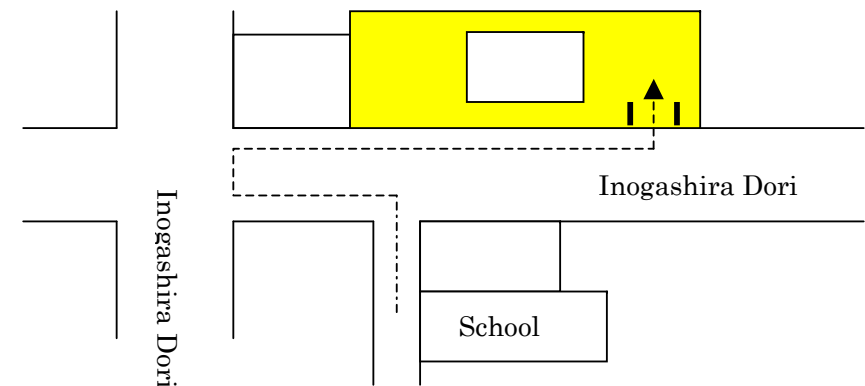
Intensive Japanese class will be offered to children ages 4-12 years old.
