Tuition Due Date: May 24th

No refunds are available after May 24th.

If payment is not received by the due date that is written in the invoice, your child's space will be automatically cancelled.

Important Notes

Please be advised of the following:

1. Extended hours program is available (please see below).
2. Registered days can be changed to other days **up to 3 times** if:
 - a) there is availability on another day
 - b) the request is made by 8:45am of the registered day.
3. Lunch:
 - a) Students can bring a packed lunch.
 - b) Lunch can be ordered through Kiwi Kitchen.Please note that the school will not reheat or refrigerate students' lunch.
4. Morning drop-off service is available from 8:45am to 9:00am.
5. No medication (including prescription drugs) will be administered during the summer school. Please ask your physician to prescribe medication dosages twice per day if necessary.
6. During the summer school, students explore many areas based on each theme, including but not limited to food related activities. The school always conducts safe and appropriate food activities with the utmost care, especially considering those who have allergies. Please indicate food allergies and or dietary restrictions if your child have any. We will not inform you of each food activities. If you have any questions, concerns, or you wish to be informed, please notify the school office.
7. The composition of the class is subject to change depending on the numbers of students.
8. Yoyogi International School does not have facilities or trained staff to support students who need physical/behavioral/educational support.
9. Late application may result in not securing your child(ren)'s place.

After-School Extended Hours Program

After school extended care will be available daily until 6:00pm at the Pre/K campus.

1. Sign-ups can be daily or weekly.
2. Payment should be made daily via prepaid tickets (sold at the School Office; ¥5,580/set, 310/15min).
3. Refund for unused prepaid tickets will be available **only if refund requests are made by the end of Summer School (August 9th)**.
4. Please be sure to pick your child(ren) up on time. Any late pick up after 6:00pm will be charged **¥1,000/15min**.
5. Invoice and receipt will not be issued.

Program Descriptions

Preschool/Kindergarten Program

The Preschool/Kindergarten program uses the same curriculum as its regular school year program. It offers Language & Literacy, Math, Science & Social studies, Music, Art and Crafts, Physical Education, and some fun water activities! Preschool/Kindergarten summer classes are open to both Yoyogi International School students and Non-Yoyogi International school students, except Little Penguins class. Little Penguins class is offered only to the current Yoyogi students and the children who are registered for the Penguins class and or Little Penguins class in the 2019-2020 school year. Please note that children must be 16 months old by June 10th, 2019.

Primary Program

In the Primary program, students will work on their academic skills; Math, Reading and Writing, to review and reinforce the knowledge in preparation for the next academic year. This will also be balanced with Science, Creative Arts and fun outdoor activities. Outdoor activities include cycling at Yoyogi Park Cycling Course and some Physical Education (PE) lessons on the sports ground next to the school. Taking full advantage of our premier location, students will go to Yoyogi Park every day for recess time if weather permits. Additionally, students will have opportunities to go on excursions to explore local museums or facilities. Please note that there will be no swimming lesson this year.

Intensive Japanese Program (June 10 - July 12)

Would you like your child to learn more Japanese? Here's your chance! From the moment when students step into our Intensive Japanese classroom, they will be immersed in Japanese language and culture. Our experienced Japanese teacher will provide an excellent program that each student will be able to enhance their Japanese speaking, writing and reading skills. The program promotes students to make a stronger connection with their host country, Japan. This year, the class will be offered only to the Primary students.

Application Guidelines

1. Applications shall be accepted via strictly receiving a filled application form. Application form can be sent via e-mail attachment, postal mail, or handed to the School Office.
2. Additional Days:
 - a) Additional days may be added after the application form has been submitted. Additional days request must be made by 8:45am of the day that you wish to add
 - b) Payment must be made before the class of the additional day(s).
 - c) Please fill out the ***Change Days/Add Days/Cancellation Form*** and submit to the School Office, or send it via e-mail.
3. Changes to Attendance:

Registered days may be changed to other days **only 3 times** if:

 - a) there is availability on the requested day
 - b) the request is made by 8:45am of the registered day.
 - c) Please fill out the ***Change Days/Add Days/Cancellation Form*** and submit to the School Office, or send it via e-mail.
4. The following children have a choice to attend 2-5 days a week.
 - a) current Yoyogi students
 - b) children who are registered for the 2019-2020 school year
 - c) Yoyogi International School graduates
 - d) current Afternoon Class students
 - e) children who are in “Primary 2 age group” children and above (please refer to the previous page; Primary Program-Age Group description)
5. Students that are not in the above categories have to sign up for 5 days a week.
